

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

the National Council of Architects, Planners, Landscape Architects and Conservationists, having its registered office in Rome, via Santa Maria dell'Anima no. 10, (Fiscal Code 80115850580), hereinafter for the sake of brevity, also the CNAPPC, in the person of its President and Legal Representative, Arch. Giuseppe Cappochin, domiciled for his office at the CNAPPC registered office and with full signatory powers in his quality as President of the CNAPPC;

the Architects' Council of Europe, having its registered office B-1050 Brussels, 29 rue Paul Emile Janson (Tax Identification no. – VAT no. BE0 464 884 970) hereinafter in brief also the ACE, in the person of its President and Legal Representative, Arch. Luciano Lazzari, domiciled for his office at the ACE registered office and with full signatory powers for the stipulation of this agreement in his quality as President of the ACE

and

the European Association for Architectural Education, having its registered office in Universiteit Hasselt, Campus Diepenbeek, Agoralaan gebouw E, B-3590 Diepenbeek (Belgium) (Tax Identification no. – VAT no. BE432.722.443) hereinafter in brief also the EAAE, in the person of its President and Legal Representative Karl Otto Ellefsen, domiciled for his office at the EAAE registered office and with full signatory powers for the stipulation of this agreement in his quality as President of the EAAE.

Whereas

the CNAPPC was formed in compliance with art. 10 par. 1 of Legislative Decree of the Lieutenant of the Realm no. 382 of 23 November, 1944, of the Ministry of Justice and is a public non-profit association with mandatory membership, whose purpose is to coordinate and oversee the Italian Order of Architects, Planners, Landscape architects and Conservationists, and whose organization includes one hundred and five Provincial Orders;

the CNAPPC is entrusted by the Orders with the safeguarding of the title and exercise of the profession, and consequently pursues the goal of promoting and expanding the professional opportunities of the professionals listed in the Register and support the values of environmental, social and financial sustainability in the processes of territorial development, transformation of the city and in the design and construction of buildings, as well as in improving the efficiency and saving energy in existing structures;

the CNAPPC, as part of its function as coordinator and supervisor of the Order's system, also promotes policies and actions intended to raise the level of architectural quality, its environmental sustainability, technological innovation and the technical competence of sector operators;

the Architects' Council of Europe (ACE) represents the profession of architect at the European level. It was founded in Treviso on 11 May, 1990 and contributes to those areas of EU legislation that impact on the practice of architecture and on the policies that affect the overall quality and sustainability of constructed areas.

ACE's objectives include the promotion of architecture in Europe, support for sustainable development of constructed areas, the guarantee of elevated standards of training for architects, support for quality in architecture, promotion of international cooperation and facilitating European practice

The European Association for Architectural Education is a non-profit association founded on 1 September, 2014. Its mission is to promote the quality of architectural training, and it aims to improve the store of shared knowledge and the quality of teaching in urban and architectural design. Its mandate also includes the establishment of a European network of schools of architecture, for the promotion, discussion and exchanges of a shared plan at European level to improve the quality of architectural training.

In the pursuit of its statutory goals, the EAAE establishes relations with governmental, international and professional authorities and organizations, coordinates and facilitates dialogue between the different associated schools, promotes the organisation of networks on the subject, through conferences and workshops, points out critical aspects concerning architectural training and research and works to sustain academic excellence.

Whereas

ongoing professional updating and development is a prerequisite for sustainable economic growth and a positive step forward not only for specialized sector operators but for society as a whole, interpreting the objective of guaranteeing, in the interests of everyone, a constant professional adaptation to dynamically evolving technical and scientific applied research, as well as an ongoing updating of knowledge, in the service of achieving a qualitatively high level of professional performance;

training and research are important strategic factors favoring growth and progress, and investments should therefore be made in the sector, in a measure commensurate with the production and socio-economic needs of each single local entity;

competence, competition and innovation are the keys to the development of complex and emerging knowledge, in line with the needs of a dynamic social and economic system that is increasingly open to international career growth;

the Parties express a shared interest in promoting policies and actions intended to improve the quality of architecture, its environmental sustainability, technological innovation and the technical competence of its operators;

Whereas

ACE has scheduled a meeting of its General Assembly for 5 May, 2017, in Rome, ACE, EAAE, CNAPPC have agreed to organise a joint Symposium on 6 May 2017 on the subject "Education and Practice – the Future Architect"

Now, therefore, in view of the above, the Parties hereby stipulate the following:

ART. 1 - Preamble

The premises above are an integral and substantial part of the present memorandum of understanding.

ART. 2 - Object

The Object of this memorandum of understanding is to structure the organisation for the entire duration of the ACE General Assembly in Rome, on 5th May and the ACE,

EAAE, CNAPPC symposium on 6th May, also including meetings of an educational nature of interest to the Parties.

ART. 3 – Obligations of the Parties

the CNAPPC, for the realization of the Object indicated in art. 2 above, shall contribute € 25,000, which shall be utilised to partly cover the out-of-pocket expenses incurred for travelling and **no. 3 overnight stays** in a hotel for 3 people from the ACE Secretariat, rental of a conference room on 5 and 6 May, technical services + 1 technician for 5 and 6 May, the cost of the 2 interpreters from ACE (translation + travel + 3 nights in hotel + local transfers + meals), Coffee break (4 - 5 May morning and afternoon + 6 May morning and afternoon) and a buffet lunch (5 May and 6 May);

The ACE, for the realisation of the Object indicated in art. 2 above, shall remit to the CNAPPC, as host nation, all delegates fees (eg 75 X 200€ = 15.000 €) it will receive, which will partly cover the out-of-pocket expenses listed above, and it will guarantee a minimum payment of 12,000 €. The ACE will draw up the graphics of the booklet and the events and the event agenda, in collaboration with the EAAE

The EAAE, for the realisation of the Object indicated in art. 2 above, shall pay the CNAPPC, as host nation, € 6,000, solely for the realisation of the one –day conference on 6 May, to be organised jointly by EAAE / CNAPPC and the ACE. The EAAE shall be responsible for the graphics of the Conference programme, in collaboration with the ACE.

Press releases, event programs, booklets, posters and any other materials relating to the event indicated in art. 2 above shall be submitted in sufficient advance for approval by all the Parties, and the publishing costs agreed upon in advance and allocated to a specific Party, also to be agreed upon.

The ACE and the EAAE shall pay the amounts agreed upon above to the CNAPPC by means of bank transfers BANCA POPOLARE DI SONDRIO ABI 05696 - CAB 03227 - C/C 000002250X43 - CIN N - IBAN IT 12 N0569603227000002250 X 43 - SWIFT POSOIT2D2 with the following object: "Joint ACE-EAAE Symposium in coordination with CNAPPC", in a single payment, **no later than 28 April, 2017.**







ART. 4 - Representatives

For the planning, scheduling and coordinating activities required for the implementation of the actions described in this memorandum of understanding, the Parties each appoint a representative.

The CNAPPC appoints **Corine Veysse**

The ACE appoints **Caroline André** and **Gerardo Ambrosecchia**

The EAAE appoints **Inge Lens** and **Hugo Dworzak**

ART. 5 - Amendments

Any and all amendments and addenda to this memorandum of understanding must be agreed upon by the Parties and shall become effective after the stipulation of a second document, approved by the competent representatives of each Party and duly signed by the same.

ART. 6 - Disputes

The Parties agree on the amicable resolutions of any disputes that may arise from this memorandum of understanding.

To this end, any dispute or controversy that may arise as a result of the interpretation, execution or termination of this memorandum of understanding shall be remanded to the opinion of a board of arbitration composed of a representative designated by each of the Parties and a President appointed by common agreement, in compliance with the provisions of the laws in force. Should this not be possible, exclusive jurisdiction is granted to the Court of Rome.
